**Horses on Coxs Road:** 18-19 May and 15-16 June. Ian and Trish reported on the tour of Dick Austen's property 5 November. Duncan, Ian, Keith Painter (publisher of Pocket Pals), Trish attended. River crossing ideally to Glenroy but may have to be more distant. Liddleton Woolshed available for catered evening get together of walkers, non riders and riders. Duncan has asked Tracy Green to cater. Tracy has agreed.

**Hartley Rocks Entertainment:** Duncan reported. Pat is available.

**Mike O Kane and Lynn Collins:** Joan reported on good progress on costing "Images" and "How To". Text writing by Joan is underway. The school site is thought entirely suitable.

**Garden at the School:** Ian asked about plans for landscaping and planting. Suggest Lithgow Community Nursery and Robbie suggested Lithgow Council Parks and Gardens as part of the LCC in kind support.

**Commemoration Stone:** marking the Coxs Rd. Should be publically accessible and adjacent to school grounds?

Vital that consultation occur with Wiradjuri. Helen spoke about the lack of consultation re LCC removal of granite boulders to Hyde Park.

Joan has contacted Power House Museum. Quite supportive. Have costumes.

Joan tabled BMCC promotion from Gazette newspaper. Although funded by BMLOT this promotion has little evidence of "Lithgow Oberon Tourism". Also noted that no invitation issued to Lithgow Council to join in the reception at Government House.

**Media Partners:** 2LT. Mercury. Helen spoke of NAIDOC experience, says 2LT better value than print media. Heather suggested human interest story in Mercury.

Robbie spoke of call for submissions on significant sites. Response from Patsy Moppett. Robbie will send photographs of Mt Blaxland sites as possible inclusion on Visit NSW and BM Crossings websites.
