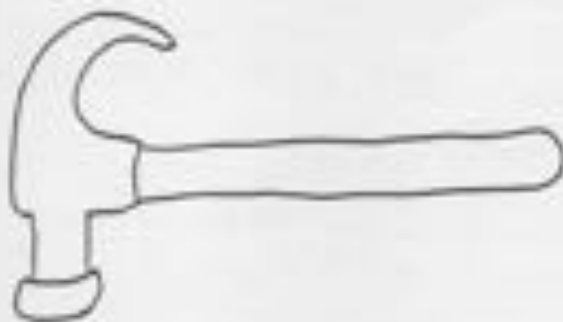
## CEP WORKS HAVE STARTED !!
