FUTURE ROADWORKS, Brown's Gap Road and Cos's River Road - Lithgow City Council advise that major reconstruction and rehabilitation of the existing and failed sections of Cox's River Road (\$250,000) and Brown's Gap Road (\$150,000) are programmed to commence in the coming twelve months.

Mt Victoria to Lithgow, Great Western Highway Upgrade - Roads and Traffic Authority notice:

The highway through Mt Victoria village is narrow with a number of historic buildings close to the road. There is minimal opportunity to improve the road on the existing alignment with no possibility of providing additional lanes. The highway through Little Hartley is also narrow and constrained with a number of historic buildings close to the road.

The RTA invites residents to community meetings to discuss what we see as the objectives for an upgrade of the highway.




