#### **Meeting with Duncan Gay**

Michael Combs (on Blackman's Creek Road), raised issue that they have experienced huge increase in noise since River Lett Hill safety upgrade. Have Roads & Maritime Services monitoring levels.

## **Finance Report**

Treasurer reported funds on hand of \$6,308,

incorporating \$1,488 of HHAG funds \$466 of 1813 funds with

balance of \$4,354 available HDPA funds.

Noted separate funds of \$28,000 held by Hartley Recreation Reserves Trust to fund building repairs and shelter shed. Discussion regarding these funds clarified that they are Trust's not HDPA's.

## **Business Directory**

Discussed costs and effort associated with production of fridge magnet, directory and website. Duncan Wass confirmed he has directory production down pat.

Noted additional value of quarterly newsletter version now. Offerring new starters at \$15 per newsletter and \$25 for A5 brochure distribution.

Agreed to modify offer 2012 renewal to directory 4x newsletter and website, cease fridge magnet. Pricing as now \$77 and \$120. Automate by invoicing for assumptive renewal.

Agreed entries on website only as part of paid package.

Duncan Wass reported on 2013 meeting at Workies. Some success with attendance of 30 odd. Many from Lithgow Gardening Club.

Updated meeting on time table images exhibition 4<sup>th</sup> May to 16<sup>th</sup> June.

Tor dedication 1<sup>st</sup> June followed by community event and dinner.

History conference slipped to 8<sup>th</sup> June.

Invitations to NSW Governor and Premier going out this week. Need to add Robyn Parker.

Ramsay Moodie briefed meeting on 2<sup>nd</sup> June history workshop. Primarily to think about pre 1813 valley and to engage Aboriginal community. Some good discussion. Great input from Kath Schilling OEH.

One idea, creation of a mechanism to aggregate artefacts into a valley-held and publically accessible collection in a process that honours and pays tribute to the finders/holders who have kept them safe all this time. This might be a mechanism for both European and Aboriginal artefacts.

All part of the bigger strategy to make Hartley Valley a place renowned for its heritage.

In afternoon group inspected two Aboriginal scar trees on Southleigh and the Collits Aboriginal sharpening grooves.

# **Building Restoration Committee Report**

Duncan Wass summarised recommendations of engineer.

Replace gutters with period gutters,

underfloor looks very sound,

foundations good,

relocate tank, overflow compromising east wall foundations.

Concrete slab along east wall will stabilise foundations.

No decisions taken on recommended actions.

Painting to proceed asap.

Duncan Wass to take a board to mate in Bathurst for purchase of replacements for rotten ones. Check Mitre 10 Bill Humes.

Then proceed with prepare and paint quote of \$5k.

Ramsay Moodie: What about frost? Painter can advise on suitable paint type.

Seamus Casey advised \$20k grant for new shed to be spent by March 2013. Various options wood/rusticwood/brick stone/stone.

Quotes are in. Trustees will decide next week.

Hopefully the community will like it. Will sound out a few people to get views and asked for views through newsletter.

Seamus Casey advised two grant applications submitted to Lithgow council, one trust one HDPA. Narrowed down to Trust one to potentially cover refurbishment of toilets.
