Hartley Valley Strategy

We will again have Melanie Jones and Mathew Johnson from Lithgow City Council with us at next Monday's meeting to tell us about with Hartley progress the Village Improvement Plan; Council's name for a strategic plan to make the whole Hartley Valley a better place to live. In January, survey forms were sent to every residence in the valley, in addition survey forms were available off the Council website and Council did a lot of promotion of the project including at 'Back to Hartley' last year. In total, Council received 88 responses to the survey that will now be used to drive specific proposals for improvements. The surveys returned suggest the following are priorities; Transport, public toilets, BBQ tables and shelters, rest areas, Information Bay or board, Signage promotion, increased tourism, Roads, Garbage bins and service, Heritage and history preservation and promotion/ and of increased better use HHV. Litter/weeds, Rubbish, Business diversity, TV service/internet/radio. Come and hear where Council have got to on this project and if you feel any concerns are not addressed in this list come and let council know your views.


